





 - Admissions Pipeline by Financial Aid Need
 - Incoming Freshman Report
 - Financial Aid Awards in Progress
 - Policy Data Sharing Agreements
 - Financial Aid Awards in Progress double dipped
 - Example Collection as repository of data sharing agreements.
 - Option 1 Policy doc as collection attachment; link to spec. Note lose 1:1 connection between spec and DSA.
 - Option 2 Collection as collation of reports that utilize a DSA. Attach DSA to Spec. Link specs to Collection. Attach blank DSA template to Collection
 - Permissions included with Specifications
 - Report Manager –BI Lisa Lang
 - Report Writers jill yun
- Create new Admissions Pipeline Lisa Lang

Demo – Create New –

- Starting Point Create Collection or Create Specs?
 - Start with Specs, then Collection. Can only link the 2 at the Collection page, so have the specs ready to avoid revisiting Collections.


Default Workflow

- 1 Conditional
 - Functional Area



Permissions

Embedded with Specifications Add Spec to Collection, not vice versa



Use Cases

- Annual Report
- Fact Book
- Complex Dashboard
- Operational report bundles
- Policy

Search and discovery

- Search and Indexing
 - Home Search
 - Approved Objects keyword "upstream"
 - Indexes Collections, only returns the Specifications
 - Browse Search
 - Specifications keyword "upstream"
 - Retrieves specifications linked to a Collection that contains search keyword. NOTE the specs themselves may not contain the keyword.
 - Collections
 - Retrieves collections that contain the keyword.

- List of Related Objects
- 2 Step Process
 - Indicate Yes/No
 - Respond
- Purely informational. Does not affect Workflows.

Related Objects

Related objects are impacted by changes to the object

Object	Related Objects
Definitions	Specification Quality Rule Reference Data Data System
Specification	Definition Collection Data System
Collection	Specification
Quality Rule	Definition
Reference Data	Definition, via Quality Rule
Information Request	Can become a Specification
Quality Issue Resolution	Can become a Quality Rule

- From an Approved Spec **Student Listing**, request a Change. Note no impacts listed on Approved.
 - Version in progress, has impacted definitions
 - Indicate yes/no
- Anyone can edit Impacts during the workflow. Edits overwrite earlier decisions.
